

Boone County Fair Campgrounds
Regulations and Rates
Adopted January 2008

Definitions

1. "Basic unit" or "basic camping unit" means the portable shelter used by one to six persons. Examples of a "camping unit" include tent, travel trailer, pop-up camper, motor home, or livestock trailer with living quarters without livestock with prior approval.
2. "Camping" means the erecting of a tent or shelter of natural or artificial material, or placing a sleeping bag or other bedding on the ground or parking a motor vehicle, motor home or trailer for the purpose of overnight occupancy.
3. "Immediate family" means parents, dependent children and grandparents.
4. "Modern area" means a camping area, which has showers and flush toilets.

Regulations

1. Noise: Creating or sustaining any unreasonable noise in any part of the campground is prohibited at all times. Noise that can be heard at a distance of 120 feet or three campsites shall be considered unreasonable between the hours of 10:30 pm and 6:00 am. This includes generators, motor vehicles, motorized toys, or audio devices such as radios, televisions, public address systems, musical instruments, or any other device causing unreasonable noise.
2. The use of paintball guns in the campgrounds area is prohibited.
3. Waste receptacles are normally provided in the camping area and will be emptied on a regular basis. Household, commercial, or industrial waste brought from private property cannot be emptied into the waste receptacles.
4. Firearms, fireworks, explosives, or weapons of any kind are prohibited in the campgrounds.
5. Fires are not permitted on the campgrounds. Manufactured grills are permitted as long as it is in good working order.
6. Alcohol consumption: Beer (with an alcohol content of 5% or less by weight) and wine (with an alcohol content of 17% or less by weight) can be consumed in the campgrounds area only by adults of legal age (21 years or older). Keg beer is not permitted in the campgrounds or any part of the fairgrounds.
7. Camping is permitted in designated campgrounds only. All campers must register. Registration must be made in the name of the person 21 years of age or older who will occupy the camping unit for the term of the registration.
8. Campers will be furnished with an area to camp, drinking water (where available) and sanitary facilities. Camping units can use only the electric hook-up designated for their site. Extension cords cannot run from one site to another.
9. Each camping unit is allowed to park one vehicle not used for camping at their site. All other vehicles must use the parking outside the camping area. All driving is to be confined to designated roadways and is restricted to properly registered motor vehicles and motorized vehicles authorized by the Boone County Fair Board.
10. The use of motor scooters, electric bikes, and similar devices is prohibited. Personal electric mobility devices may be operated with the requirements of Section 321.235A of the Iowa Code.
11. Privately owned dogs and cats shall be kept on a 6-foot leash or kept confined. Animals are not allowed to run at large and must stay in the campground area. Any animals causing problems will be asked to be removed from the camping area by their owner.
12. Payment of camping fees is due at the time of registration.
13. The Boone County Fair Board will handle violations of any of the regulations.
